Love Moves Us equips communities, churches, agencies and individuals to respond to the needs of foster & adoptive children & families by forging church partnerships, creating service opportunities, and providing monthly “Family Gatherings” where families receive free childcare & dinner and are able to come into community with others for encouragement and support.

Instead of struggling alone, children see other children who look like them & whose families look like theirs. Parents are supported, encouraged & given parenting tools to help them. 100+ WWC’s philanthropic efforts will make a tangible difference in the lives of hundreds of children in Will County by providing sensory toys for children to play with at our Family Gatherings, as well as gift cards for families to take care of immediate needs. 100+ WWC is a philanthropic group formed for local women who are interested in supporting their communities by contributing to Will County charities together as a group to increase the donation impact. All 100+ WWC members/teams make a pledge to donate \$100 four times a year. At each of the quarterly meetings members nominate charities, three are chosen at random, and after a brief presentation, the members vote on which charity to support. Once the winning charity is announced, everyone writes a \$100 check, on the spot directly to that charity. All charities nominated must be located in, and serve Will County and must have 501(c)(3) non-profit status.
