### **100+ Women Who Care of Will County Donate to Trinity Services**

On May 14, 2019 members of 100+ Women Who Care of Will County donated \$3,800 to Trinity Services, Inc.!

Sherry Ladislas, Director of Development, and Trinity staff members were presented the checks by members of 100+ WWC of Will County. Trinity Services, Inc., founded in 1950, is a nonprofit, nonsectarian organization that provides the highest quality person-directed services and supports to people with disabilities and mental illness. We are guided by a philosophy of servant leadership—a commitment to placing the needs of others before one's own.

“We are so grateful for the generosity of 100+ Women Who Care of Will County,” Ladislas said. “This money is going to help women and children who receive support from our Homeless Support Team. It will help purchase things they need when they first move into a home, like clothes, school supplies, diapers and bedding.”

100+ WWC is a philanthropic group formed for local women who are interested in supporting their communities by contributing to Will County charities together as a group to increase the donation impact. We meet 4 times a year in February, April, September and November on the 2nd Tuesday of the month. The meetings are 1 hour long from 6:00-7:00. At each of the quarterly meetings members nominate charities, three are chosen at random, and after a brief presentation, the members vote on which charity to support. Once the winning charity is announced, everyone writes a \$100 check, on the spot directly to that charity.
